Cabinet examined the revised version of the Third Development Plan 1969-74 and agreed to publish the Plan subject to minor amendments, such as the grouping of subheads 4, 6, 7 and 8 of the Roads programme under one heading to allow a measure of flexibility.

It was also agreed that reference should be made in the body of the Plan to a study which is to be carried out in connection with the St. Paul's Bay Bypass.

OPM. 1281/68. H.E. the Governor - General was advised to exempt the aircraft which took part in the Malta International Air Rally between the 3rd and 5th October, 1970, from the payment of landing and parking fees.
