Attached Declaration describes a small plot of land at Ghasri Gozo earmarked for public acquisition by absolute purchase.

The Land is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136 in connection with the Ghasri Road Scheme.

The sum involved as it emerges from the report of the Land Engineer amounts to £61. 16s. Od.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Ghasri, Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 8.5 Kejliet, bounded on the North and on the South by property of the Cathedral Church of Gozo, on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Saviour Attard.

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 143/63 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta, Malta.
