

MEMORANDUM FOR CABINET BY THE MINISTER OF
INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM

Customs duty on car imported by Mr M. Micallef

Mr Michael Micallef of 128, Cross Road, Marsa, has applied for exemption from customs duty on a motor-car which he is importing. The car will be fitted with modified controls as Mr Micallef is suffering from congenital paralysis of the upper arms, as a result of which he cannot drive a normal car.

2. An investigation has been carried out by the Police into the financial situation of Mr Micallef and it has been established that Mr Micallef is employed as a part-time watchman with the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology at a wage of about £3 per week. His father earns about £6 per week and his brother, Anthony, also earns about £6 per week. The family also comprises his mother and two sisters none of whom earn money.

3. Similar applications have been approved in the past, on humanitarian grounds, and Hon Ministers are invited to agree that in this case too His Excellency the Governor should sign an Exemption Order under section 13 of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance (Cap. 122).
