

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor General covers **three plots of land at Luqa.**

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The acquisition involves:-

Item (1) plot of land of the area of 4 sieghan and 9.7 kejliet.

Item (2) plot of land of the area of 1 tomna and 2 sieghan

Item (3) a plot of land of the area of 6.5 kejliet

The acquisition of these three plots of land is required for the construction of a children's playground and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Cap. 136.

It emerges from the valuation report made by the Land Engineer that the freehold value of:-

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa.

1. A plot of land of the area of 4 sieghan and 9.7 kejliet, bounded on the South by property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin, on the North-West and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which the said plot forms; it is the property of Mr Raffaele Dalli.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomna and 2 sieghan, bounded on the North by property of Mr Raffaele Dalli, on the South-West and on the South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which the said plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin.
3. A plot of land of the area of 6.5 kejliet, bounded on the East by property of Mr Raffaele Dalli, and on the North-West and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which the said plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Fiott.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 61/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
