

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to premises at No.75, Gunlayer Street, Vittoriosa.

Since the premises in question are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire the under public tenure.

These premises, which were demolished through enemy action, are required by Government in connection with the reconstruction of the area and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer, it transpires that the compensation payable for the acquisition of the above premises by way of public tenure amounts to five pounds twelve shillings (£5.12s.0d.) annually.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of public tenure.

Description of the Land

Premises No. 75, Gunlayer Street, Vittoriosa, property of the "Cassa Messe" attached to the Collegiate Church of Vittoriosa.

The above mentioned property is shown on a plan marked L.D. 21/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
