

Memorandum for the Cabinet by the
Minister of Justice and Parliamentary Affairs.

Delivery of certain property which fell under the provisions of the Treaty of Peace (Italy) Order, 1948, to Italian Nationals.

Certain property in Malta which belonged to Gio Battista Caruana, Flavia Giobbi nee Caruana and Bianca M. Bertolotti, all being Italian nationals, was subject under the provisions of the Treaty of Peace (Italy) Order, 1948, to certain charges, specified in that Order, and was for that purpose in the possession under the exclusive control and administration of the Administrator of Italian Property.

There is no reason now why the said property should be so charged and controlled and it is, therefore expedient that it should be released from the said charge and delivered to its owners. This may be done under the provisions of the said Order by the Governor-General and Honourable members are, therefore, being requested to advise His Excellency accordingly.
