

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Cap. 136).

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of a plot of land at Luqa.

As this plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required in connection with the formation of a street, linking Dokkina Street, at Luqa, with New Street, it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £1,509. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa:-

A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan and 6.5 kejllet, bounded on the North-East by New Street, on the North-West by a public passage way and on the South-West partly by property of Mrs. Grazia Spiteri, partly by property of Mr. Salvator Brincat and partly by property of the Parish Church of Luqa; it is the property of Mr. Francis Penza.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 356/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
