

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of a plot of land at Nadur, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required for the purpose of widening the Victoria - Nadur Road in Gozo; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £11.3s.4d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Nadur - Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 6.7 kejliet, bounded on the South by Victoria/Nadur Road, on the East by property of Mr. Salvatore Camilleri, on the West by Government property and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of the Noble Alexander Apap Bologna.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 363/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
