

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of a plot of land at Attard.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required in connection with the extension of "Tal-Kmand" Nursery; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £334. 6. 8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Attard:-

A plot of land of the area of 4 tmien 5 sieghan and 4 kejliet, bounded on the North partly by an alley and partly by property of Mr. Harry Craig, on the South by property of the heirs of Guistu Camilleri, on the West by property of the heirs of Anna Deguara and on the East by property of Maria Muscat; it is administered by the Very Reverend Canon Paul Borg.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 340/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
