

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of three tenements and a plot of land at Victoria, Gozo.

Since the tenements and the plot of land in question are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The said tenements and the said plot of land are required in connection with the building of a school; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above three tenements and of the above plot of land amounts to £1,125.12. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR - GENERAL.

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land.

The following land at Rabat, Gozo:-

1. Unnumbered tenement in Racecourse Street, consisting of two rooms, one overlying the other, accessible through an open passage, bounded on the South by Racecourse Street, on the East, partly by tenement No. 88 and partly by tenement No. 89/90 Racecourse Street and on the North by property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo, it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo.
2. Tenement No. 88 Racecourse Street, property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo as regards the Directum Dominium and of Mr. John Vella as regards the perpetual Utile Dominium.
3. Tenement No. 89/90 Racecourse Street, property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo as regards the Directum Dominium and of Mr. John Camilleri as regards the perpetual Utile Dominium.
4. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 3.17 Kejliet bounded on the North by Government property, on the West by property of Mr. Salvatore Vella and on the South partly by property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo and partly by property of Mr. John Camilleri; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Gozo.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 339/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
