MEMORANDUM BY THE HON. MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFIARS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Marsaskala.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required for conversion into a public garden; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £5,372. 4s. 6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
