

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land at Mosta.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening and the formation of a square; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the seven plots of land in question amounts to £4430. 10. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Valletta Road, Mosta.

1. A plot of land of the area of 52.75 square canes, bounded on the South and East by Valletta Road, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Bezzina.
2. A plot of land of the area of 12.2 square canes, bounded on the East by property of Parish Church, Lija, on the South by Valletta Road, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Bezzina.
3. A plot of land of the area of 44.67 square canes, bounded on the South by Valletta Road, on the East by property of Mr. Joseph Vella and on the North partly by property of Mr. Consiglio D'Amato, and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Lija.
4. A plot of land of the area of 4.64 square canes, bounded on the North, South-East and South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Lija.
5. A plot of land of the area of 124.3 square canes, bounded on the South by Valletta Road, on the West by property of the Parish Church of Lija, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Vella.
6. A plot of land of the area of 20.42 square canes, bounded on the South by Valletta Road, on the West by property of Mr. Joseph Vella, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Fenech.

7. A plot of land of the area of 6.93 square canes, bounded on the South and East by property of the Parish Church of Lija, and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Consiglio D'Amato as regards the perpetual Utile Dominium, and of the Parish Church of Lija as regards the Directum Dominium.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 135/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
