

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF
JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Luqa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the formation of a new road; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £235. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Luqa:

A plot of land of the area of 44.6 square canes, including half the width of an alley, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr. Andrew Scicluna, on the South-East partly by property of Mr. Andrew Scicluna, and partly by an alley, on the South-West by New Street, and on the North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Mrs. Josephine Debono as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 5/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
