

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at Gudja.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £839. 4s. 8d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Gudja:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 tozna, 1 siegh and 8.85 kejllet, bounded on the South and East by Main Street, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 3.4 kejllet, bounded on the South-East, East and South by a public road, and on the North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Peter Giordannina.
3. A plot of land of the area of 3 sieghan, bounded on the North-West and South-West by a public road, and on the South-East partly by property of Mr Joseph Sacco and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.
4. A plot of land of the area of 9.5 kejllet, bounded on the North-West by property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina, and the South-West by a public road, and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Sacco.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 346/38, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
