

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land in the limits of Mosta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the construction of a pumping station; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £252. 8s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land in the limits of Mosta:

A plot of land of the area of 1 tozza and 5.2 kejllet, bounded on the South by Mosta Road, and on the North and West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr John Mary Attard and others as regards the temporary utile dominium, and of Mrs Josephine Bugaja as regards the directum dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 251/68 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
