

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Zerafa Street, Marsa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required by the Government for the prolongation of Zerafa Street, Marsa; they are, therefore, required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the two plots of land in question amounts to £441. 0.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zerafa Street,

Marsa:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 33.2 square canes, comprising part of a farmhouse, bounded on the North-East by Zerafa Street and on the South-East and North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Rosaria Grech.
2. A plot of land of the area of 73.7 square canes, bounded on the North-East by property of Mrs. Rosaria Grech, on the South-West by Zerafa Street, and on the South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of unknown and uncertain owners.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 328/68 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
