

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY

AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises with garden known as "Villa Buleben" at Rabat, Malta.

Since the said premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The said premises are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the premises in question, including the garden, amounts to £7,500. Os. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

Description of the land

The following land at Rabat, Malta:-
