

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Zabbar.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the widening of St. Joseph Road, Zabbar; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £726. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zabbar:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 23 square canes, bounded on the South-East and East by Saint Joseph Street, on the North-West by property of Mr. Carmelo Darmanin and on the South by property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Mary Chesney Sceberras D'Amico Inguanez.
2. A plot of land of the area of 13.3 square canes, bounded on the South-East by Saint Joseph Street, on the West by property of the Most Noble Baroness Frances Mary Chesney Sceberras D'Amico Inguanez and on the North by property of Mr. Carmelo Darmanin.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 310/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
