

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Santa Venera.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with the erection of a Telephone Exchange; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £200.15s. 6d.

The attached Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No.713 dated the 21st October, 1966, in so far as plots Nos.1 and 2 referred to in that Declaration are concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Santa Venera:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna, 2 Sieghan and 0.19 Kejliet, bounded on the North and West by Government property, and on the East by property of Mrs. Elizabeth Cassar; it is the property of unknown and uncertain owners.
2. A plot of land of the area of 5.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mrs Ines Stellini, on the West by property of unknown and uncertain owners, and on the East and South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Elizabeth Cassar.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 349B/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This Declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 713 of the 21st October, 1966, in so far as plots 1 and 2 are concerned.
