

## MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

## AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Marsa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the extension of the Marsa Industrial Estate; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £842.0.0d.

This Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 729 on the 7th November, 1967, in so far as Plot No. 5 described in that Declaration is concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.


Description of the land

The following land at Marsa:

A plot of land of the area of 6 Tmien, 3 Sieghan and 7 Kejliet, bounded on the North East by property of Mr. Carmelo Fenech A.&C.E., on the South East partly by property of Dr. George Schembri and others and partly by property of Dr. Leslie Grech and others, and on the North West by property of Marquis Scicluna; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Spiteri and his wife Carmela.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D 186/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 729 dated 7th November, 1967, in so far as plot 5 is concerned.
