Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Zebbug, Malta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £513.15s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zebbug, Malta:

A plot of land of the area of 82.2 square canes, bounded on the North and West by road Ta' Batu, and on the East by St. Mary Street; it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Cortis as regards the Utile Dominium and Miss Giuseppina Cortis and others as regards the Directum Dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 95/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
