MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises at No. 35, Scots Lane, Cospicua.

These premises are required by the Government in connection with a Reconstruction Scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136). Besides, in view of the purpose of this acquisition, it is proposed to acquire the premises in question on public tenure in accordance with the with the approved policy.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the recognition rent of the above premises amounts to £9. 2s.0d per annum.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of Public Tenure.

Description of the land

The following land at Cospicua.

Premises No. 35, Scots Lane, Cospicua; they are the property of Mr. Salvinu Agius and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 94/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
